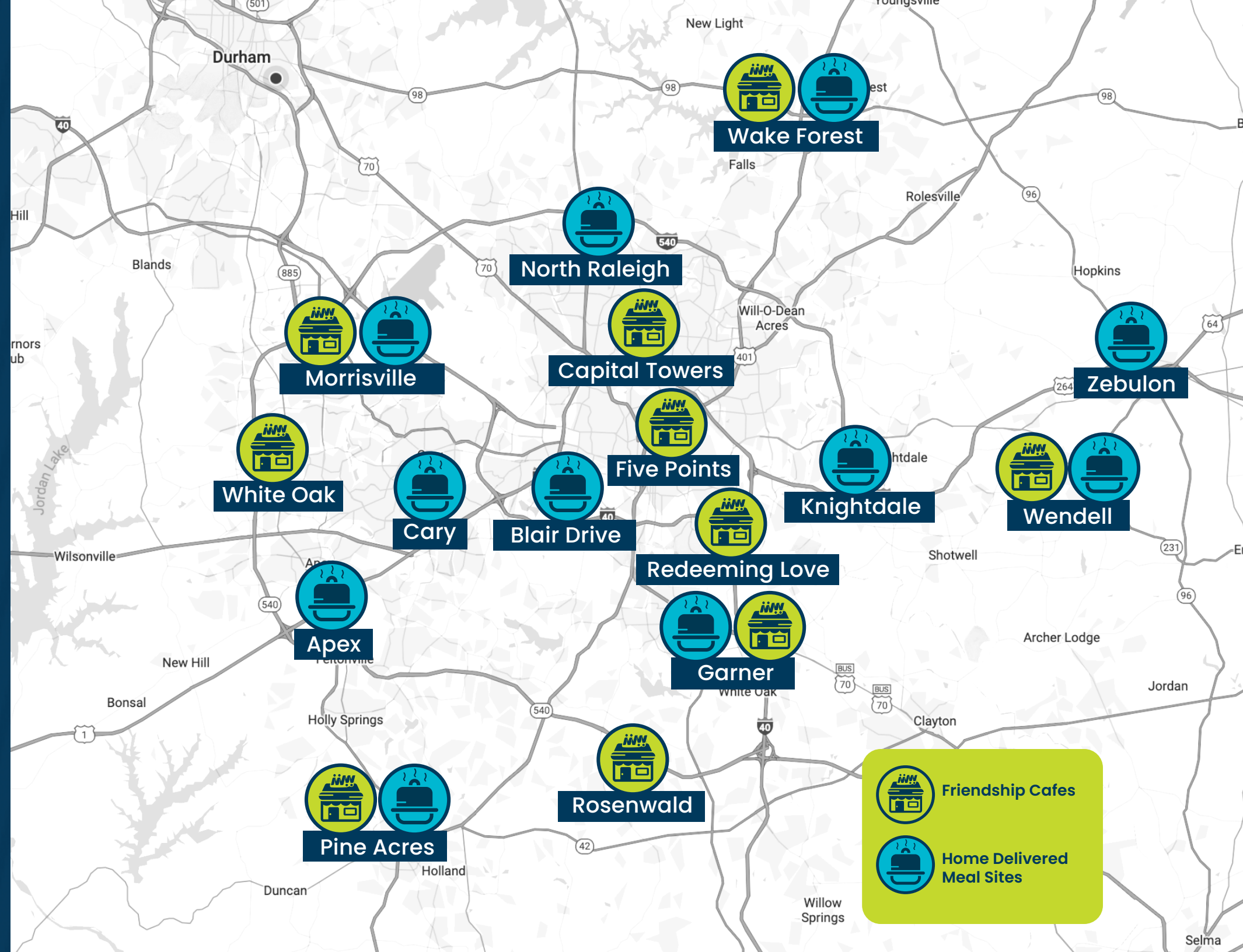

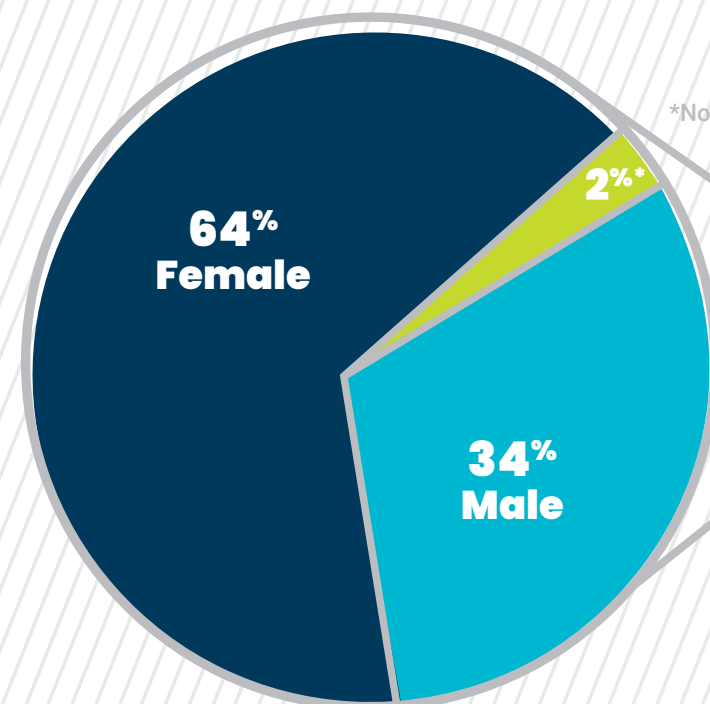

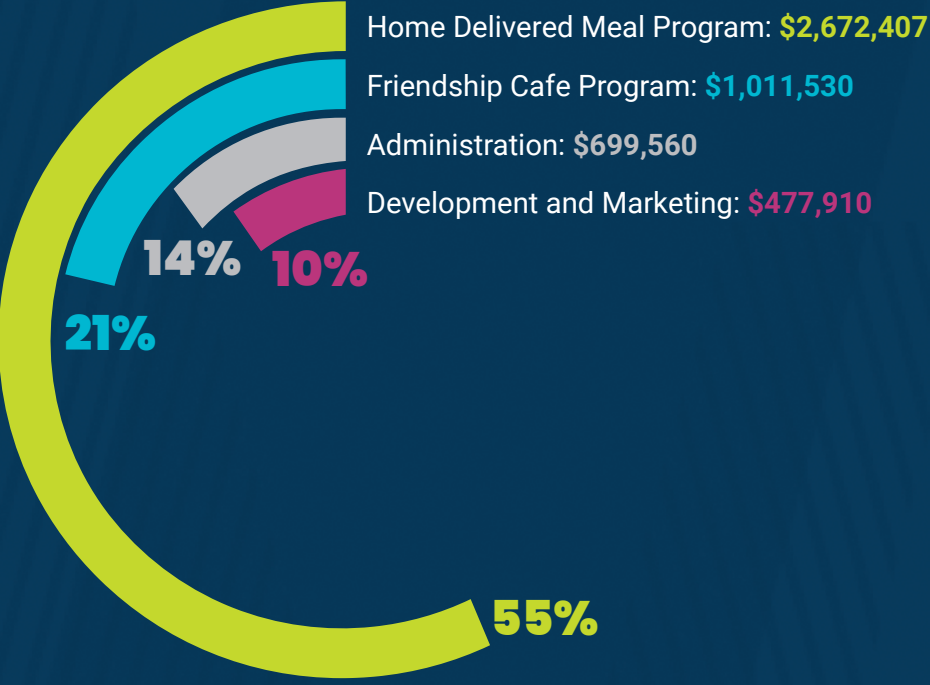

Meet our friend, Lucienne.

For Lucienne, life has always been art. A prolific artist born and raised in Louisiana, she spent most of her life surrounded by beautiful creations of her own making, which now adorn the walls of her Raleigh home. But life, like art, is full of unexpected turns.

Seventeen years ago, when her first grandchild was born, Lucienne and her husband moved to Raleigh to help care for him. One night, while her daughter and son-in-law were out, Lucienne headed downstairs for a glass of water. “I fell down the full flight of stairs,” she says. “I broke everything and got a concussion. It was terrible. That’s when the neuropathy started.”

Since that fall, Lucienne now navigates life in a wheelchair. Though her cheerful spirit and creative talents remain boundless, her life became confined by physical limitations. “This has been my life for the past 17 years,” she says gesturing toward her wheelchair. “It’s been very limiting. I used to get out and do so many more things.”

But she hasn’t stopped creating. Her Raleigh studio — tucked into a sunlit corner of her home — remains a sanctuary. “This is my happy place,” she says. “Turning 80 has been the biggest shock for me — because when you turn 80, all of a sudden, you realize the ride’s not going to last much longer, and you want to do something that’s really going to be meaningful and special.”

For Lucienne, meaning is found through her art and her community. With meals becoming harder to prepare — “Just to do something as simple as boil a pot of pasta,”

“Some months ago, somebody called and said, ‘We’re just checking to see if you’re okay,’ and I just thought, that is amazing. Now I’m okay — but there are so many people living alone, just to get that phone call is really special. Those are the things I really appreciate about Meals on Wheels.”

she explains, “I’ve got to get myself up, stand over it, reach, turn the dial — it’s very hard” — Lucienne turned to Meals on Wheels for support.

“It’s been a huge help for me. The volunteers are totally charming, and it’s nice to connect with them,” she says. “On Tuesdays, it’s Roger — he’s so pleasant. I love our delivery people.”

Lucienne appreciates the meal deliveries, but more than that, she has gratitude for the people who help make them possible.

In a city she’s grown to love — “I just think Raleigh is amazing,” she says. “I haven’t been surprised by its growth and success” — Lucienne has found more than a new home. She’s found connection, meaning, and support. Meals on Wheels is honored to be a part of her story — a story that, like all great art, is vibrant and full of life.
